

Dr. John D. Roth
Keynote Presenter



Professor John D. Roth, Goshen College, is the keynote presenter. His address will explore the healing of memories from the perspective of the persecuted Anabaptists.

Professor of history at Goshen College, he is director of its Mennonite Historical Library and editor of *The Mennonite Quarterly Review*. He has authored several books, among them *Choosing Against War: A Christian View* (Good Books, 2002) and *Beliefs: Mennonite Faith and Practice* (Herald Press, 2005). Roth has spoken throughout the Mennonite church on its history and faith. From 2000-2004 he participated as a member of the ecumenical Liaison Committee of the Mennonite Church USA and the ELCA. This summer he will represent North American Mennonites in conversations between the MWC and the LWF.
