Ecumenical Ecclesiology

That Christ has made humanity one by the blood of his cross is a New Testament given. Living out that oneness is another matter altogether.



Throughout the church's history, it's nature and shape, purpose and mission have generated a variety of accounts, depending on its status in society and the theologies of specific communities of faith. Is something like an ecumenical ecclesiology emerging, an expression that might inform all traditions? Or is ecumenical ecclesiology more a matter of a method for reconciling diverse ecclesial structures? Can ecumenical ecclesiology suggest something more satisfying than a catalog of the many ways church is organized and structured?

These and related questions will be explored formally in presentations from mainline Protestant, Orthodox, and African-American perspectives. Informally, all participants will have the opportunity to offer insights from their own traditions in small group discussion and open dialogue...
